Examination Results for May-June 2008

We received the **Cambridge IGCSE** and **GCE A'Level** results for **May-June 2008**. The results are good basing on individual candidate per candidate and excellent pass rates for the school as a whole. We registered an overall pass rate of **99%** in the **IGCSE (S.4)** and **90% pass rate** for the **A'levels**. This is a big achievement in such a short period. The Students and their Parents are very happy, likewise the Staff and Management are equally satisfied with the achievement gained so far.

The collaboration effort of the following key stakeholders enabled us achieve this feat so quickly: -

- (1) **The Board** through its **Executive Committee** provided guidance, supervision and financial resources for us to accomplish our task. We had unlimited resources from funds for practicals, scholastic materials to on-spot allowances for teachers who taught extra.
- (2) **Management:** The current Management is of serving classroom teachers (including the Headmaster) who have a hands on Curriculum and Instruction expertise.
